DECISION

This is an application by Trimida Limited for renewal of an on-licence in respect of premises situated at 2-6 Wharf Street, Warkworth, known as Thai Warkworth.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matters on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.22 of the Act. We renew the licence on the existing terms and conditions until 26 March 2016, that being three years from the last renewal of the licence and authorise the issue of a replacement licence.

AUCKLAND DISTRICT LICENSING AGENCY - NORTH

PURSUANT to the Sale of Liquor Act 1989, **TRIMIDA LIMITED** is authorised to sell and supply liquor on the premises situated at 2-6 Wharf Street, Warkworth and known as "**Thai Warkworth**", for consumption on the premises to **any person who is present on the premises** and to allow the consumption of liquor on the premises by any such person.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Part 6 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale of liquor, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments and low-alcohol beverages.
- (b) **Liquor may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:**
On such days and during such hours as the premises are being operated as a restaurant but not other than on the following days and hours:

Monday to Sunday 7.00 am to 1.00 am the following day.

- (c) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when the premises are open for the sale of liquor in accordance with the menu submitted with the application for a licence, or variations of that menu of a similar range and standard.
- (d) The licensee must ensure that signs are prominently displayed within the licensed premises detailing information regarding alternative forms of transport from the premises.
- (e) The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of liquor.
- (f) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of liquor to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

In terms of Regulation 7 of the Sale of Liquor Regulations 1990 the sale, supply or consumption of liquor is authorised in the premises generally. The premises, situated at 2-6 Wharf Street, Warkworth, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Rodney District Licensing Agency on 26 February 2003.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Wharf Street is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.

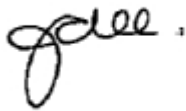
**APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF ON-LICENCE:
