Your licence expires on 26 March 2016. Your risk rating category is Medium and your renewal fee is \$ 816.50.

If you fail to get your application to Alcohol Licensing at least 20 working days before the expiry date of your licence you must provide an explanation for your failure. If your explanation is not accepted by the District Licensing Committee your current licence will expire and you will need to apply for a new licence. You will also not receive a refund of the application fee.

**Making an application**

To renew your licence, please return the attached application form, all requested documentation, this letter and applicable fee to Auckland Council. If you wish to vary the hours or conditions of your existing licence at the time of the renewal process, please specify this on your application.

**Public Notification**

Once you have lodged your application with Council, please ensure that you notify the public in the manner set out on our website. Go to [www.aucklandcouncil.govt.nz](http://www.aucklandcouncil.govt.nz) > Licences and Regulations > Alcohol > Apply for or renew an alcohol licence > How to place public notices.

Your notices must be published in the name of the applicant stated on the application form (i.e. the correct company or organisation name).

Copies of all notices must be sent to us once they are published. Please send the full page of the paper your public notices appeared in (or print the page from the internet site [www.alcoholnotices.co.nz](http://www.alcoholnotices.co.nz)). Please be sure to highlight or circle your notice. Your alcohol licence will not be issued unless you provide copies of your public notices to the Committee.

**New Alcohol Licensing Fees**

In October 2013 we advised licensees of a new default fee system introduced by Parliament under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The national default fees came into effect on 18 December 2013 and the regulations applying to Renewal fees are:

- Payment is on the anniversary of your premise licence
- An annual fee will also be payable and you will be sent a separate notice with the details
