Note: Failure to comply with this notice may render you liable to prosecution.

For Occupier's information: Plants declared noxious within the Rotorua district.

Class A: Johnson Grass, Australian Sedge, Cape Tulip, Coltsfoot, Pennisetum macrourum, Cestrum Sasiculatum

Aquatic Plants: Salvinia, Water Hyacinth, Water Lettuce, Manchurian Rice Grass.

Class B: Barberry, Blackberry, Broom, Barley Grass, Bind Weed, Budolia, Gorse, Hemlock, Nodding Thistle, Ragwort, Stinking Mayweed, Sweet Briar, Thorn Apple, Variegated Thistle, Winged Thistle.

Aquatic Plants: Egeria, Parrots Feather, Ferny Azolla, Hornwort Lagarosiphon, Nassella Tussock.

Road Frontages: The occupier is responsible for the control of noxious plants to the middle line of the road that may bound the said property.

Appeals against the requirements of this notice may be made within 14 days of receipt of this notice on the grounds that the requirements are unreasonable. The appeal must be made in writing, addressed to the District Noxious Plants Authority and accompanied by a fee of \$10.00. The appeal will be referred to an independent arbitrator under Section 50, Noxious Plants Act 1978.

Penalties: Failing to control or eradicate Class A plants, \$5,000, or if the offence is a continuing one, \$200 per day for every day or part thereof that the offence continues.

Failing to control or eradicate Class B plants, \$2,500, or if the offence is a continuing one, \$150 per day for every day or part thereof that the offence continues.
